<b>Abstract</b>	
<p>In accordance with Art. 1 of this order, the employer shall undertake to transfer the salaries of his workers regularly to the branches of recognized banks that they may specify.</p> <p>The Minister of Labour shall take steps to implement this regulation, which shall come into effect the day after it is published in the Official Journal (Art. 2).</p>
